EMM/ECU Limited Warranty

This product is subject to the following conditions should an Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc product prove defective due to faulty workmanship or materials.

1. Our products are warranted to the purchaser for a period of 1 (One) year or 100 (One Hundred) hours from the date of purchase.
2. This warranty does not apply to product damage due to (a) Abuse, misuse, *overheat, improper installation, accident, external sources, or any act of god, (b) If the product is altered or repaired by anyone other than Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc.
3. Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc will not be obligated for installation errors or damage made by individuals, servicing dealers and/or mechanics.
4. Should a product prove defective on workmanship or materials, the remedies shall only be repaired or replaced at the sole discretion of Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc.
5. This warranty specifically excludes any and all incidental or consequential damages.
6. All warranty return products must be returned to Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc with a Return Authorization Number.

Unless prohibited by applicable law, all implied and expressed warranties made by Advanced Engine Electronics, Inc in connection with product are limited to 1 year/ 100 hours from the date of purchase and no warranty, expressed or implied, shall be applicable after this period. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty may last or exclusions and limitations of incidental or consequential damages.
